TITLE

Airport Capital Improvement Plan (ACIP) Review

RECOMMENDED PDSC ACTION

Provide feedback on ACIP format, projects, and prioritization. Refine draft ACIP for Airport Commission review.

SUMMARY

The Airport Capital Improvement Plan (ACIP) is used to plan, prioritize, and fund significant infrastructure projects. These projects are essential for maintaining, upgrading, and expanding airport facilities to ensure safety, efficiency, and capacity to meet current and future demands.

The ACIP spans a 5-year period and is regularly updated to reflect changing priorities, funding availability, and emerging needs. It is a critical tool for effective management, enabling the Airport to plan for future growth and improvements in a structured and financially responsible manner.

The purpose of this agenda item is to refine the 2025-2029 ACIP draft for initial Airport Commission review at the August meeting. 2023 and 2024 are included in the plan for reference. Prior to final review and approval in October, Airport staff will coordinate the Colorado Department of Transportation (CDOT) Division of Aeronautics and the FAA to further develop the plan. Per the Intergovernmental Agreement, this annual update does not need to be approved by the City Councils.

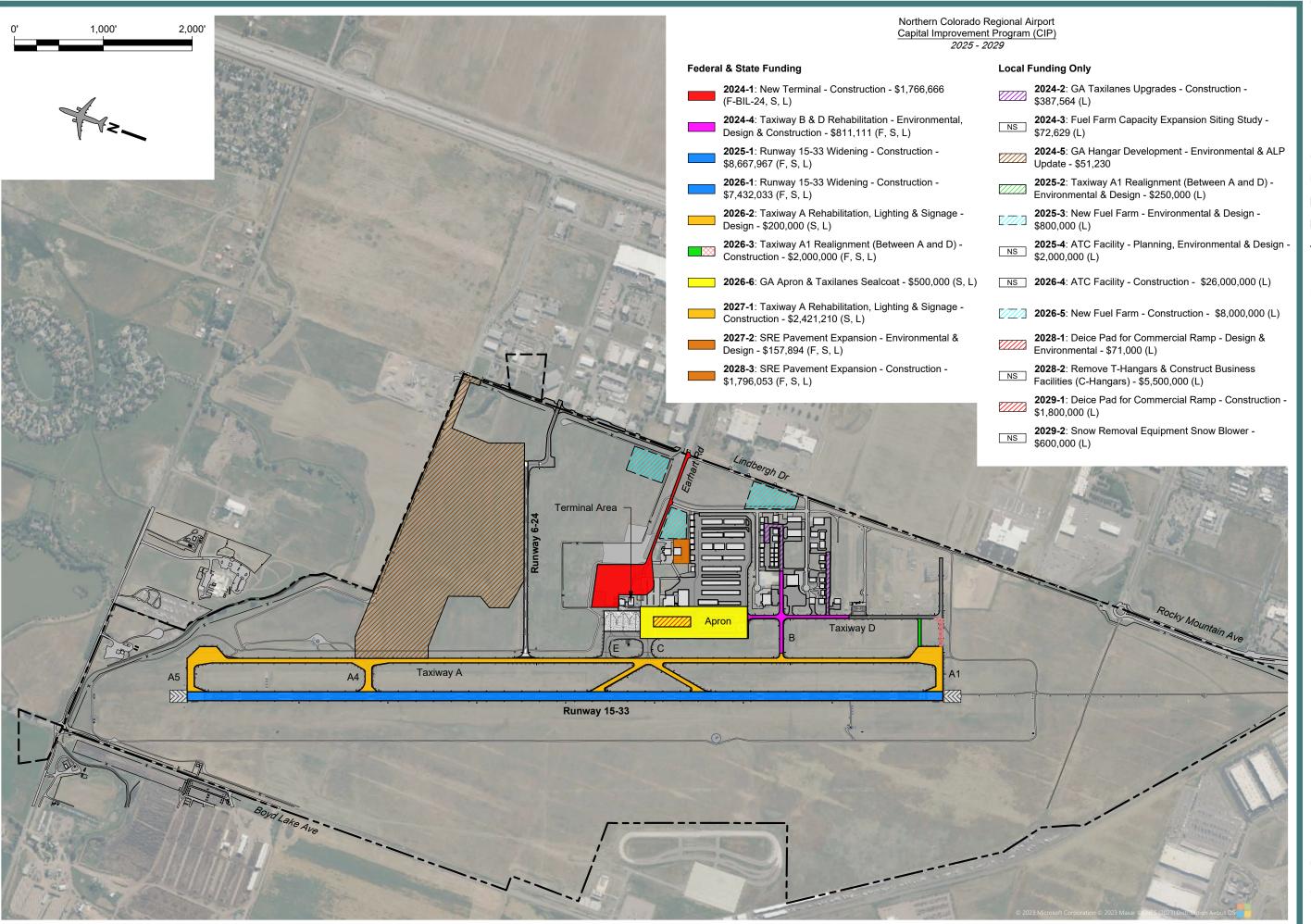
