AOA Rebadge & Gate Use






- All AOA badges expiring 10/31/2024
- Available M-F 0800-1630 Including during lunch
- Original ID Documents required
 - I-9 Document list
- \$25 payable by Check or Card



Gate access is controlled using an electronic badging system.


- 1. To open a gate, bring your badge close to the card reader as shown to the right.
- 2. To exit, move your car close to the gate and a sensor in the pavement will open the gate. Or use the push button.
- 3. After pulling through the gate, ALWAYS wait until the gate is fully closed before continuing. If you are exiting the Non-Movement area and another vehicle follows you out, last vehicle is responsible for waiting until the gate is closed



NORTHERN COLORADO REGIONAL AIRPORT

- Use the gate closest to your destination and travel with purpose. Wandering on airport is not permitted.
- Always Stop and Wait for the gate to fully close before proceeding. (35 Sec)
- If the gate is closing when you arrive, wait until it is fully closed before scanning your badge. This allows the person ahead of you to clearly see you do have a valid ID badge.
- The reason for this is a badge may be deactivated for an individual, where their access badge will still appear valid, however they will not be able to gain access through the gate.

- Challenge any person/vehicle following you through an access point into the AOA.
- If they do not comply with your request to leave the AOA, report the incident to 911 *immediately*.






Taxiway B & D and GA Taxilane Rehabilitation 2024

Taxiway B & D Rehab



Snow and Ice Control Plan



Introduction

- Purpose: Provide information needed to maintain safe operations and understand airport procedures during winter conditions.
 - Safety is paramount
- Provide information on Airport Security







- FNL is classified as a certificated airport under Title 14 of the Code of Federal Regulations (CFR/FAR) Part 139
 - Requires the highest levels of safety and security practices to include an FAA approved Snow and Ice Control Plan.
- Regulations guide our standards and priorities.
 - FNL is required to have sufficient equipment to clear the primary runway and movement area taxiways of 1 inch of snow in ½ hour.
 - Runway 15/33 will be closed during NIL breaking action (or Runway Condition Code of 0) and remain closed until conditions are improved.
 - Runway 6/24 does not receive an RCAM code

Pavement Priorities

NORTHERN COLORADO REGIONAL AIRPORT

Aircraft safety is our top priority.


Priority 1 - Primary runway, taxiway, parking, and Emergency Access.

Priority 2 - Secondary runway and taxiways.

Priority 3 -Remaining ramp and between hangars.

Priority 4 - Landside parking and access streets.
